VICTORIA – William H. Davies, QC, the commissioner of inquiry into the death of Frank Joseph Paul, has now delivered his interim report to Attorney General Wally Oppal.

The report will be released to the public following the process required under the Public Inquiry Act, which includes cabinet providing direction to the attorney general regarding any portions of the report that must withheld by law. Following cabinet consideration, the report will be tabled by the attorney general in the legislative assembly.
